All enrolled Drivers Ed students are required by Idaho State Law to complete a minimum of 6 hours observing another driver. A good time to start is while they are working through their coursework. Use this Observation Log to document the student's 6 hours of active observation. This log must be completed to receive a driver's permit.

**Observation Items:** Acceleration/Braking, Pavement Marking, Traffic Signs/Signals, Lane Position/Changes, Intersections, Cornering/Steering, Defensive Driving, Blind Spots, Parking, etc.
